

Emergency Alerts Fair Thursday - June 22, 2023 - 10 am - noon Fireside Room

When an emergency strikes, you need immediate access to reliable and timely information. Discover the key websites and smartphone applications that will issue critical -- and even life-saving -- notifications and guidance in the event of an emergency.

The Emergency Alerts Fair will provide complete information about 5 recommended sources of information.

The Rossmoor Emergency Preparedness Organization (EPO) and the Computer Club of Rossmoor are joining forces to sponsor this free event for all Rossmoor residents. We will provide information and setup instructions for these 5 applications:

- Rossmoor Nixle
- Walnut Creek's emergency alert system (WCAlert)
- Contra Costa County's Community Warning System
- MyShake app, providing early warning of earthquakes with magnitude 4.5 or greater
- FEMA weather app

If you would like assistance with the registration process or the app set up, Computer Club and EPO volunteers will be available in the Fireside Room and the nearby Computer Center. Whether you use a PC (Windows) or Mac – or have an iPhone or Android smartphone – our volunteers can help! (Note: <u>if you will be requesting assistance with an</u> <u>iPhone, you may need your Apple ID and password</u> for the app installation ... so please bring it with you.)

We will also have handouts with instructions for those wanting to handle their own set up.

NEWSFLASH!!! The UC Berkeley Seismology Lab, the developer of the MyShake app, just informed us yesterday that two team members will join us at the Emergency Alerts Fair. You heard it here first!!
