The MyShake App Understanding Earthquake Alerts

Thursday, August 15, 2024 – 10:00am – Fireside Room



The MyShake smartphone app provides early warning that damaging shaking from an earthquake is about to occur, giving users valuable seconds to move to a safer location. But what's the science behind this popular app?

Join team members from the UC Berkeley Seismology Lab, the app's developer, for an insider's look at what makes the app tick. MyShake manager Suresh Raman will discuss the app's development and their long-term goal of capturing data from users' phones to further earthquake research.

Suresh will be joined by seismologist Sierra Boyd and data analyst Christina Valen, who handle information and outreach at the Seismology Lab.

Following the presentation (at approximately 11:00am), Computer Club volunteers and the MyShake team will be on hand to help attendees install the app on their smartphones.
